



# Water resource plans – bilateral agreement reporting

The MDBA has entered into bilateral agreements with each Basin state and territory government to bring key elements of the Basin Plan into effect from 1 July 2019. The agreements ensure that sustainable diversion limits (SDLs) are in place from 1 July 2019.

The following table sets out the agreements the MDBA has established with each Basin state and territory government, the reporting relevant to the actions contained within the agreement and the MDBA response to these actions.
